Terms and Conditions

By entering into this “Samsung Solve for Tomorrow” competition (“Competition”) you (the “Participant”) agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Any information by the Implementation Partner at www.samsung.com/in/solvefortomorrow or set out elsewhere in the application process form part of these terms and conditions.

FOR SAKE OF CLARITY, IT IS CLARIFIED THAT THE COMPETITION SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED END TO END AND INDEPENDENTLY BY OUR IMPLEMENTATION PARTNER VIZ. FOUNDATION FOR INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER, INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY DELHI (IIT-D). ALL QUERIES RELATED TO THE COMPETITION SHALL BE ADDRESSED BY FOUNDATION FOR INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER, INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY DELHI (IIT-D).

Entry into the Competition signifies acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

The Competition is divided into four phases with a selection process at each phase, so that only those participants who pass a phase can participate in a subsequent phase.

1. Definitions

“Conditions”	means these conditions of participation.
“Competition”	means the “Samsung: Solve for Tomorrow” competition
“Competition Brief”	means the brief against which the Participants must submit an Idea as part of their Entry
“Idea”	means the idea or solution entered by a Participant in response to one of the Themes
“Samsung”	means Samsung India Electronics Private Limited
“FITT” or “Implementation Partner”	means Foundation for Innovation and Technology Transfer, an incubation centre at Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi
“Network 18”	means media partner of FITT, IIT Delhi
“Entry”	means application form by team or individual
“Entries”	means every entry
“Participant”	means the individual or team that has made an Entry
“Applicant”	means each individual applying to participate in the Competition
“Team”	means groups of maximum 3 participants
“Theme”	means one of the themes as set by Samsung as the basis for the Competition
“STEM”	means Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics, a learning experience for students to focus on application of ideas

“Design Thinking”	means cognitive, strategic and practical processes by which design concepts (proposals for products, buildings, machines, communications, etc.) are developed
“Submissions”	means any (non-personal) information submitted by an Applicant at any stage
“Proof of Concept”	means demonstration of idea with evidence, in order to demonstrate its feasibility
“Finalist”	means a Participant that has been selected to take part in Phase 3 of the Competition
“Prototype”	means a pre-production sample, model, or release of a product that is used to test a concept or process
“Winners”	successful Participants who are awarded a Prize
“Samsung Hampers”	means Samsung devices such as Samsung Galaxy Tabs or keyboard covers, Samsung Laptops, Samsung Headphones, etc., as per discretion of Samsung
“Course Vouchers”	means educational vouchers for online learning in any course for shortlisted 50 teams to be availed from October 01, 2022 until March 31, 2023
“Samsung Flip”	means Samsung Flip 85” TV to be provisioned for schools and universities for winning 3 teams
“Grants”	means winning 3 teams will receive grant of maximum INR 1.14 Crores based on milestones decided by Samsung and FITT

2. Eligibility

- The Competition is open to Indian citizens aged between 16 to 22 years and the final date of the application shall be 31/07/2022. Registration of Applicant/Participants between the age group of 16 to 18 can be done only by the parent/guardian on behalf of the Participant.
- The Applicant is not required to pay any amount for application.
- Employees or agents of Samsung or its implementation agencies or any of its group companies or their families or households or anyone professionally connected to the Competition are not eligible to enter.
- Entries for ideas that are currently receiving funding or support, or which have previously received funding above Rs. 5,00,000/- in total are not eligible to enter.
- The Competition is open to individuals or teams of up to three (3) people.
- If an Applicant is making an entry for a team, the Applicant, and all team members accept, that the entry is made on their behalf subject to the terms stated herein.
- Each Applicant may only be part of one entry/application, either on their own or as part of a single team.
- Each Participant/Team may only submit one (1) Idea.
- Participants must create their own work, and not copy text, images, audio, or video recordings from third parties. In case it is found that participants are infringing any third party rights including their intellectual property rights, the participants shall be eliminated and disqualified from the competition.

- Participants that are shortlisted must be available to attend all workshops, mentoring sessions and the final pitch event as directed by the Implementation Partner, in order to be eligible to win the Competition. In case the participants fail to attend the same, they shall be eliminated from the competition.
- Each Applicant will act in good faith, reasonably cooperate with any requests from Samsung or its implementation partner, in a timely manner and not act in a manner which may adversely affect Samsung's reputation, or adversely affect the health, safety or wellbeing of Samsung or implementation partner's staff or that of any other Applicant.

Exact dates and curriculum of workshops, online classes and the pitch event will be confirmed closer to the time, and the Implementation Partner will work with Phase 2 Participants to secure convenient dates, attendance on the agreed dates will be mandatory in order to progress with the Competition.

All dates are subject to change by Samsung.

4. Phase 1 - Qualification

4.1. Participants must submit their Entry on www.samsung.com/in/solvefortomorrow by 17:00 hours (IST) on 31 July 2022 (the “Application Deadline”).

4.2 Each Participant may submit a maximum of one (1) entry.

The Entry must consist of:

- the fully completed online application form, with answers to all questions, and
- a voluntary image(s) showing the design of their idea in a PDF or PPT form. This can be super-imposed on the application form in the space given for the design
- a copy of any official document of identity

Suggest an innovative solution to address the Competition Brief on any one of the following Themes:

- Education
- Environment
- Healthcare
- Agriculture

4.3 Entries will be reviewed and judged by a panel of judges) of FITT, IIT-Delhi. The panel of judges shall review the Entries to determine the fifty (50) Entries which, in the panel of reviewers’ view, best meet the Selection Criteria for Phase 1. The decision given by the panel of judges’ shall be final and the same shall not be subject to any challenge.

4.4 The fifty (50) Participants whose Entries have the highest scores will be notified by email and shall proceed to Phase 2 of the Competition.

4.5 The selection criteria for determining the winning Entries in Phase 1 includes the following criteria (“Winning Criteria Phase 1”):

Ideas will be judged on:

- Best use of technology (app, product or service) to address one of the four (4) Competition Themes
- Consideration of the needs of the intended target audience
- Creativity and originality of the idea
- Feasibility of the solution with current technology and resources considered
- Potential for the idea to beneficially impact society and/or the environment
- Potential to reach its intended target audience

5. Phase 2 – Idea Development

5.1 Only those fifty (50) Participants who were successful and notified in accordance with clause 4.4 above can participate in Phase 2.

5.2 In Phase 2, Participants must further develop their Idea to a more complex concept based on a detailed feedback from FITT Mentors.

5.3 Participants must submit their Developed Idea as per the “Phase 2 Submission Deadline” which will be communicated to the Top 50 before the beginning of Phase 2.

5.4 Each valid submission will be reviewed and judged by a panel of judges comprised of employees or agents of Samsung. The full name of the judges shall be made available at www.samsung.com/in/solvefortomorrow. The panel of judges shall review the Entries to determine the ten (10) Entries which, in the panel of judges’ view, best meet the Winning Criteria Phase 2. The panel of judges’ decision is final.

5.5 The ten (10) Participants whose Developed Idea have the highest scores will be notified by Samsung by email and will proceed to the Phase 3 of the Competition.

5.6 Selection criteria for Phase 2 includes the following criteria (“Winning Criteria Phase 2”):

Ideas will be judged on:

- Best use of technology (app, product or service) to address one of the four (4) Competition Themes
- Clear development of the idea since its original submission at Phase 1

- Demonstrable use of research and/or testing to understand the needs of the intended target audience
- Creativity and originality of the idea
- Feasibility of the solution with current technology, resources, laws and regulations considered
- Potential for the idea to beneficially impact society and/or the environment
- Potential to reach its intended target audience
- Demonstration of design thinking
- Quality of the presentation of the idea

6. Phase 3 – Finale Pitch

6.1 Only those ten (10) Participants who were successful and notified in accordance with clause 5.5 above can participate in the Finale Pitch Event

6.2 Each Finalist will supplement their Developed Idea with a live presentation at the Final Event. The presentation will take place in front of representatives from Samsung.

6.3. If the Finalists plan to support their presentation with multimedia, the content must be sent by email to the email address provided by Final Presentation Submission Deadline.

6.4 Each developed idea as supplemented by its presentation will be assessed by a panel of judges comprised of employees or agents of Samsung. Full name of judges shall be made available on the Solve for Tomorrow website at www.samsung.com/India/solvefortomorrow. The panel of judges shall review the Entries to determine the three (3) ideas which, in the view of the panel of judges', best meet the Winning Criteria for Phase 3. The decision given by the panel of judges' shall be final and the same shall not be open to review or change.

6.5 The final results will be announced at the pitch event.

6.6 Selection criteria for Phase 3 includes the following criteria ("Winning Criteria Phase 3"):

Ideas will be judged on:

- Best use of technology (app, product or service) to address one of the four (4) Competition Themes
- Quality of detail and clarity within the final plan as showcased at the Pitch Event
- Clear development and refinement of idea since Phase 2, including creation of prototype and testing with intended target audience
- Creativity and originality of the idea
- Feasibility of the solution with current technology, resources, laws and regulations considered
- Potential for the idea to beneficially impact society and/or the environment
- Potential to reach its intended target audience
- Demonstration of design thinking

7. Phase 4 – Prototype Activation

7.1 The winning three (3) teams will receive a grant, in accordance with clause 8.3, to scale their proof of concept and develop a prototype for consumer validation.

7.2 The three (3) winning teams will get 6 full months to build a prototype which may or may not be the final product, service or app. During these 6 months, the participants will be under the mentorship of FITT, IIT Delhi.

7.3 The three (3) winning teams will be required to send a quarterly report every three months regarding the progress of their prototype.

7.4 There will be no rounds of judging in this phase.

8. Prize

8.1 The selected fifty (50) teams will receive course vouchers/coupons for each participant, for up to Rs. 1,00,000, to be availed between October 2022 until March 2023. The vouchers can be used to access any ed-tech course websites, to avail courses relevant to design thinking, STEM, innovation, entrepreneurship, business skills, management and leadership.

8.2 The top ten (10) teams in Phase 3 will receive Samsung hampers worth Rs. 1,00,000.

8.3 The three (3) winning teams will be the highest scoring finalist. The maximum funding to the 3 winning teams is capped at INR 1.14 Crores and will be released based on milestones decided by Samsung and FITT. The three winning teams also get mentorship from FITT, IIT Delhi for up to six (6) months. This is, therefore, funding support for the winning ideas, to help get these developed to a pre-production sample, model, or release of a product. The prototype can be either a physical or a digital product.

8.4 The three (3) winning teams of the Phase 3, must be available to receive and fully participate in Phase 4 of the programme from December 2022 – May 2023. The winners should be available during business hours to work cooperatively to enable to development of the prototype.

8.5 Further, members of the 3 winning teams will also receive Samsung Flip 85” for their respective schools/colleges.

8.5.1 In case 2 participants come from the same school/college, they will be given one Flip 85”.

8.5.2 In case no participant is from a school/college, they will receive Samsung products or Online course vouchers worth the same amount.

8.6 Samsung reserves the rights to disqualify Participants if their conduct or content is defamatory, offensive or contrary to the spirit or intention of the competition.

9. Use of Submissions

9.1 The Implementation Partner may, but is not required to, publish Content produced by the winners and any and all Content received by it in connection with this Competition at any time and for any reason on its website www.samsung.com, across its social media channels including YouTube (which may include paid spend), newsletter, for internal use, public relations and reporting of the Samsung Solve for Tomorrow campaign, as well as any trade shows, in its stores and channel stores and public screens, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the Competition.

9.2 Each Participant warrants that they are the person who created the Submission/Content/Work submitted to this Competition. The Participant shall indemnify the Implementation Partner and hold it harmless from and against any losses, damages, liabilities, obligations, claims, actions and demands, including without limitation reasonable legal fees, arising directly or indirectly from any breach of warranty set out in this clause.

9.4 Each Applicant agrees that Samsung and FITT, IIT Delhi, and their affiliated companies, are entitled to report about the Competition, including the Participant's Ideas, Developed Solutions and Final Solution, including for marketing purposes.

10. Personal Data - Rights To Use Names, Images and Videos

10.1 Samsung is the Data Controller for the Competition. FITT, IIT Delhi is Samsung's Data Processor for the purposes of the Competition.

10.2 Samsung and Implementation Partner shall only use your personal data for the purposes of operating and administering the Competition (including contacting the Applicants in relation to the Competition and award activities), and the below PR Purposes.

- Each Applicant that makes it to Phase 2, 3 & 4 understands and agrees that Samsung and FITT-IIT Delhi, and their affiliated companies, may use their name, location and age in publicity and marketing relating to the Competition.
- Each Applicant that makes it to Phase 2, 3 & 4 understands and consents that Samsung and FITT-IIT Delhi, and their affiliated companies, may use their personal data, such as photographs and videos, which the Participant submits in publicity and marketing relating to the Competition.
- Each Applicant that makes it to Phase 2, 3 & 4 understands and agrees that Samsung and FITT- IIT Delhi, and their affiliated companies, may take and use photographs and videos at the events in publicity and marketing relating to the Competition.

11. Legal Terms

I. Representation and Warranties by Applicant/Participant:

In case, any discrepancies are identified at a later stage, Samsung and/or Implementation Partner shall have the right to disqualify such Applicant/Participant at its sole discretion.

2. Participant agrees and consents that any and all information submitted by the Participant including but not limited to the submissions and personal information of the Participants may be required to be shared with other third parties engaged by Samsung and/or Implementation Partner, for the purposes of verifying and/or audit the authenticity of the entries received from the Participants. Further, the Participant hereby understands that such third parties may be located outside the jurisdiction of India and notwithstanding anything, each Participant consents to transfer of information (including any personal information) to any such locations.

3.
